Annual Report for the year of 2020 to 2021

"Annapurna Orphans Seva Samithi" is a non Governmental and non-profitable voluntary Organization, Rendering its Restless Services to the Poor and Marginalized sections without any Self Benefit to Eradicate poverty, hunger Dis-crimination among the Rural depressed people. Especially women, widows, children, Orphans, Senior orphans, Disabled etc.,

Apart from the above the following activities were carried during the year of 2020 to 2021.

1.Covid Services

In the last two phases of the corona disaster, more than 500 people have been distributed food parcels and medicines relentlessly for 100 days in the first phase and again for 80 days in the second phase. Psychological counseling was continuously



conducted for the covid patients and food parcels were distributed to them every day and essential commodities were distributed to the poor in those dire situations. In addition, masks and sanitizers were distributed to create awareness among the people to prevent the spread of covid.

2. **Feed the Hungry:**

We have distributed food and cloths to the Abandoned people in our Region, We have selected Distitudes who has been helpless and taking shelter in the public places and Road sides. Temple, Chowltries. Busstops, Railway Stations



Foot paths, Due to Disturbed families old age people have no care and no proper food and clothes. Consequently they have been victimizing and spoiling their health and sleeping with empty stomach. So our society



(Seva Samithi) find and feel very generous and think that no one should suffer with hungry, so we have been continuously providing food for such kind of people to fulfill their hungry stomach and relieve

them from hunger, and health, so every Day 50 to 100 people were receiving food and fulfilling their stomach and feel happy in the society.

3. **National Festivals Celebrations:**



We have continuously celebrating National festivals such as independence Day, Republic Day and conducting cultural activities in that occasion and distributing prizes and also we have explaining about the

national leaders for their struggle and fight for our nation. After celebration we have distributing chocolates, sweets to the children this activity will be conducting continuously.

4. **Health Awareness Camps:**

We have conducted Health Awareness camps in Rural Area where there is no proper medical specialties, so people have to move 20 KM for diseased treatment as they all Agriculture labour they are



unable to meet the transportation and medical expenses. Hence they have been suffering with various seasonal Disease. Due to illiteracy un-

aware of Diseases they are spoiling their Health, So we have planned and conducted Medical camp in their respected villages, invited local Govt. Doctor's the Doctor's Examined their Health and explained to them about pre-cautions to be taken seasonally and Distributed medicine for 200 people.

5. Mask, Sanitizer Distribution:

Conducted health awareness camp in the Relief time of pandemic season for poor colonies and distributed 2000 masks and sanitization and explained through awareness on Covid pre caution to be taken



and to protect them from various Diseases. We have also give awareness on Handwash and Nutrition food to be taken in this pandemic period people have awarded and following the instructions of local Doctor.

6. **Disable Welfare Activities**

We have provided clothes, Bed sheets and groceries to the Disable and old age citizens in Rural and Urban Areas. Due to severe poverty and lack of care and protection from their children the Disable and old age people are



spoiling their health and not having proper clothes and Nutrition food, so we have conducted baseline Survey in our Regional and identified very poor disable and old Age people and provided the Bed Sheets, sanitary items and groceries for their monthly needs enough. So that the Disable and old Age people protected from winter cold.

7. Free Education Centres

Efforts are being made to provide quality education to poor children, street children and begging children by organizing a free education center in different areas every evening. Following the new



education policy introduced by the government, children are taught



mathematics, English, And free training is given by experts in various arts like drawing, magic, mimicry, talking doll, micro-character painting, dance, singing, music, and rural games like kolatam, karra samu, and

competitions are organized and prizes are presentd. Similarly, computer training, development programs and motivation training classes are being conducted for the youth.

8. Skill Development Programmes:

Special training in martial arts is also being given to women and girls for self-confidence and protection. Poor women, widows, orphans, skill development programs are being conducted to provide livelihood to



poor women, especially sewing machines, animal husbandry, hotel management, grocery shop and store management etc.

9. Bedsheets distribution:

Blankets were distributed to the elderly, the poor, the orphans, and those living in tents.



!0. Water & Sanitation Awareness:

Awareness programs on the importance of water and sanitation were organized among the public and students, as part of which, wide publicity was done on the Swachh Bharat program and the



awareness of the environment was raised among the people.

11. Motivational Trainings:

Various motivational types of training classes were conducted among the youth and students, special awareness programs were conducted the among youth especially on the value of



Concentration, Memory, Self Respect, Time Management and suicide.
